A. Tuition Fees for the 2009-2010 Term:

Tuition: \$100 per child/\$300 maximum per family

Book fees: \$15 per child

Sacrament fees: \$25 for First Reconciliation; \$25 for First Communion/ \$50 for Confirmation

Tuition and Fees can be paid using checks (made out to St. Mary REP), credit card or cash

B. Re-registration of children PREVIOUSLY in the program:

Please **thoroughly** complete **ALL** the attached forms and return with payment. **Note: Permanent Records are being updated this year and ALL Sacrament Information must be on file.** If you have not previously sent in a Baptismal Certificate, please do so. These need to be on file with your child's records. **Incomplete forms will not be accepted.**

C. First time registration of children of REGISTERED PARISHIONERS who are new to the program, including kindergarten, and 1st graders:

1. Please **thoroughly** complete **ALL** the attached forms and return with payment. **Incomplete forms will not be accepted.**
2. Please send copies of **Baptismal certificates** along with registration form.

D. FALL & WINTER Sessions: 3 Options:

1. **Saturdays** 9:30 – 11:30 twice a month, grades **K-7**
2. **Tuesdays** 5:30 – 7:30 twice a month. Week A, grades K-8 alternates with Week B grades K-8
3. **Family Catechesis:** Families meet together one Sunday a month from 2:00 – 4:30 PM
Interactive sessions are completed at home during the course of the month, grades K-8

E. SUMMER Session:

The summer session will take place from July 6 – July 17. Classes meet M-F from 9:00 to 12:00 noon. **Due to the popularity of this session and limited space in the school, registration will be limited to actively participating parishioners who have been registered with St. Mary for one year. *****

*****All** registration forms, whether mailed in or dropped off, **WILL NOT** be considered until the end of the workday (4:30pm) on February 9, 2009. Registration will be chosen by **lottery** and you will be notified by mail of your status.

Children in sacrament grades (2nd & 8th) who attend the summer session will be required to attend further sacrament preparation sessions during the fall and winter prior to the reception of a sacrament.

When registering, you must choose a 1st, 2nd and 3rd choice. If your 1st choice is filled, you will automatically be given your 2nd choice, etc.

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FAMILY CATECHESIS

Family Catechesis is an option available to families, especially to parents, who wish to be more involved in their children's religious formation. This approach is based on family learning and faith sharing. The parents act as the primary catechist, which you are, as you gather with ALL of your children at the same time. There are interactive sessions, designed to be used at home, along with the children's text- books. This unique program allows children of various ages to learn on their own levels, yet discuss, pray, and complete activities together with the whole family. The Sunday sessions would then gather all families involved in this program to do activities, share prayer, and focus on the liturgical year. Families share the responsibility of leading prayer, organizing activities, and hosting refreshments.

Children in sacrament grades (2nd & 8th) who participate in Family Catechesis will be required to attend further sacrament preparation sessions before the reception of a sacrament.
